- Finalist of the KB19 Emerging Artist Prize will be notified in February 2019 via e-mail or post
- The winning applicant of the KB19 Emerging Artist Prize will receive an opportunity to create a
 fully funded art work for the second Karachi Biennale in October 2019, a unique medallion, and a
 four day visit to KB19. The Artist's travel, boarding & lodging expenses will be covered
