WHAT IS IT?

The Untold Edition is an award winning community project designed to encourage fearless art making and blur the lines between insider and outsider art. This inaugural residency will focus on collaboration and understanding contemporary art in a post-truth, digimodernist world.

WHEN IS IT?

The residency will take place during the month of July.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN?

Participating artists will be asked to maintain an online blog and a visual journal/sketchbook for the entire duration. They will have group sessions weekly with founder Kehkashan Khalid to encourage a creative mindset. Once a week, a visiting artist will lead an online discussion on the topic of that week.

WHO CAN BE A PART OF IT?

An open call will be put out on June 10th and end on June 25th. Interested artists will apply through submission of a personal statement, bio and portfolio. Selected artists will be notified by June 29th.

WHAT WILL BE THE OUTCOME?

Participating artists will be encouraged to create new work, but new work is not a necessity. They will emerge with a compilation of thoughts in their sketchbooks and their online blogs. Any new work created will be exhibited in an online exhibit.
